

Centre approves city's first Public-Private Partnership Project

The city's first Public-Private-Partnership project in solid waste management has received approval under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM). The project paves way for the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation earning carbon credits by developing landfill gas recovery systems at the sites in order to reduce Methane emissions. The Waste Management strategy for treatment and disposal of Mumbai's 6,000 tons per day of municipal solid waste which focuses on environment friendly technologies including Composting and Biomethanation has been developed by IL&FS
